Sub Group Club Services

Composition of the Group

- Chair of a club council/management committee
- Golfer with expertise in Strategic and Financial management
- CGI staff member who has been involved in identifying service supports required by clubs, providing the supports and evaluating them.
- Golfer with expertise in providing online self-help resources to a service industry
- Golfers who have served at least three years on a club council/management committee in a strong solvent club.
- Equal gender.

Scope/Understanding

- Propose an appropriate range of services which the OGB should provide to golf clubs and to club members, taking account of the range of clubs in Ireland.

Tasks

- Review the report of the DGs national consultation on OGB to identify club service needs requested by clubs in that process.
- Consult with clubs on services they would like OGB to provide to them as a club and to their members, prepare questions to be included in survey of clubs
- Identify and evaluate services provided by OGBs elsewhere
- Rank the service needs of clubs in order of priority
- How services should be provided, individual staff/ consultant led, club or regional based training programmes, online information portal, online community/ chatroom.
- Provide a written report on the groups suggestions to the DG
- Identify secretarial/ supports required to complete the work of the subcommittee.
