Course Rating and Handicapping

Composition of the Group

- A member from the GUI/ILGU National Course Rating Committee and two members from each Union's ILGU/GUI National Handicapping Committees
- An administrator from the GUI or ILGU offices, who looks after Course Rating and/or Handicapping

Scope/Understanding

- Research current practices in both the ILGU and GUI i.e. how it is carried out. National Vs District/Branch – for both Handicapping and Course Rating
- Outline best practice initiatives taken from international course rating seminars
- Understand the implications for Ireland of potential implementation of WWH in 2020
- Comprehensive understanding of Course Rating (experience in having rated a course) and handicapping (experience at club level and/or District/Branch level)
- Have attended an ILGU/GUI course rating seminar

Tasks

- Suggest ideal model for course rating based on national and international examples
- Create list of golf clubs that have and have not been slope rated
- Train District/Branch teams on bogey and scratch setup
- Detail report on how handicapping and course rating could work together ahead of the implementation of WWH
- Educate clubs on slope and how the system will work
- Draft a brief on how men and women in clubs could start working together on handicapping
- Make recommendations/proposal for clubs regarding implementation and monitoring of handicapping
