Future Club Formation

Composition of the Group

- Chairperson of a Management Committee/Council of a golf club
- Male and female who have been club captains and served a minimum of three years on a Council/Management Committee (current or ex officio officers)
- Person with experience of organisational structures/ restructuring, preferably not having been involved in club structures and young
- Reps from proprietary and private members clubs.

Scope/Understanding

- Members should have knowledge of club management and management practises and challenges in clubs.
- Members should have experience of organisational best practise and be objective observers of current arrangements. Members should be able to commit a day per week for a max period of 4 months.

Tasks

- Identify current management responsibilities in golf clubs, (membership, greens, finance, HR, Health and Safety, licensing, legal, juniors, competitions, handicapping, communication, marketing etc)
- Research the range of current management structures in golf clubs, identify areas of overlap and duplication e.g. running competitions, finance, handicapping, juniors, social
- Propose models of good governance for clubs for the future.

Communication/Output

- Liaise with DG nominee following each meeting and as required
- Short written progress report for DG following each meeting



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- Draft report for discussion with DG proposing a range of fit for purpose management structures for clubs
- Final report for DG.
