### Composition of the Group

- National Chairperson of Rules from ILGU and GUI
- In addition, a member of the National Rules committee from both organisations
- Rules administrator from the offices of the ILGU and GUI
- Irish representatives on EGA or R&A rules committees
- Gender balance key.

### Scope/Understanding

- Understand how both organisations administer Rules and how the National Rules committee is structured
- Research best practice from both organisations in relation to e.g. rules schools/exam, meetings, communication, tournaments, reporting
- Have an good understanding of how the R&A works and the guidelines to be followed
- Research the way Rules is administered and practiced Internationally as well as in Ireland
- Outline the best approach to the continuous development of world class Rules Officials.

### Tasks

- Examine current on course and in-house practices and propose a joint best approach based on ILGU and GUI Rules structures
- Document a report and propose an approach to Rules in the new GB.

### Communication/Output

- Set up frequency of meetings with DG member to report on progress
- Members to outline all tasks and split based on areas of expertise
- Group members to conduct quantitative research and draft findings
- Draft final report of all group work and output to DG
- Prepare final report for DG.
