Composition of the Group

- Representatives from GUI Provinces and ILGU Districts (Gender neutral and max. 8)
- A spread of experience across a range of areas. (Council/Committee, Championship/Rules, Handicapping, Teams, Inter Club, Juniors)

Scope/Understanding

- All activities involving volunteers excluding Provincial Council and Board matters
- A commitment of one day a week is anticipated but may be more/less as the task evolves.

Tasks

- To examine the existing ILGU/GUI District, Provincial & National structures and determine differences
- From all, determine what is best and decide what changes would strengthen and improve the current system
- Research volunteer structures for other amateur sporting bodies.
- Dream a gender neutral structure
- Draft a NEW structure and a report with observations and recommendations
- Discuss the report with the DG.
